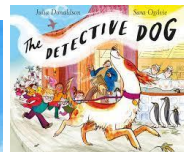
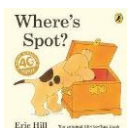
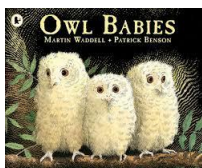
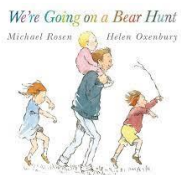
Autumn Term 2023

Communication and Language

Listening and attention is the key skill we need to develop in our communication journey. Every day we learn to show good listening skills. We get better at taking turns with others and knowing when we have to wait for something or someone.

Physical Development

Now that we are in Nursery we will grow in independence. Every day we will dress for outdoors, go to the toilet and wash our hands. At snack time we will learn how to eat and drink independently. We will learn how and why it is important to brush our teeth twice a day as we begin our daily tooth brushing scheme.

Personal, Social, and Emotional Development

Literacy

Mathematics

We will be joining in with number songs, saying some number names in sequence. We will be learning to complete jigsaws and puzzles.
