The Wedding at Cana

There was a wedding at Cana in Galilee, and the mother of Jesus was there. ² Jesus also was invited to the wedding with his disciples. ³ When the wine ran out, Mary said to Jesus, "They have no wine." ⁴ And Jesus said to her, "Mother, what does this have to do with me? My hour has not yet come." ⁵ His mother said to the servants, "Do whatever he tells you."


⁶ There were six stone water jars there, each holding twenty or thirty gallons. ⁷ Jesus said to the servants, "Fill the jars with water." They filled them up to the brim. ⁸ And he said to them, "Now draw some out and take it to the master of the feast." So they took it. ⁹ When the master of the feast tasted it and he called the bridegroom ¹⁰ saying to him, "Everyone serves the good wine first, then the poor wine later. But you have kept the good wine until now."
