



School Uniform

The wearing of school uniform is compulsory. This includes the PE kit for all lessons. Please ensure that all items of clothing are clearly named.

Boys in Year 1 - Year 6

Navy blue school sweatshirt
White shirt
School tie
Grey trousers
Socks should be appropriate school colours: White, grey, blue or black.
Black footwear

Girls in Year 1 - Year 6

Navy blue school sweatshirt or cardigan
White blouse
School tie
Grey skirt/pinafore dress or trousers
Blue gingham check dress for warmer weather
Socks should be appropriate school colours: White, grey, blue or black.

Please note that children in Nursery and Reception can wear a white polo shirt and do not need to wear a tie.

PE Kit

White t shirt
Blue shorts (summer) Blue/black tracksuit bottoms (winter)
Black slip on pumps for indoor lessons
Black pumps or trainers for outdoor lessons.
Children should come to school on their PE days dressed in their full PE kits. Please note, children in Nursery do not have to have a PE kit however, if you wish, you can send them into school in tracksuit bottoms and a t shirt on their PE days.

Children in the Early Years will also need:

- * A spare set of clothes in a carrier bag – labelled with your child's name to be kept in school on their peg should they need them
- * A pair of wellies in a carrier bag – labelled with your child's name
- * A waterproof suit that your child can put on and take off themselves – labelled with your child's name

Jewellery

Jewellery is discouraged on the grounds that it can be dangerous to self and others. If earrings are worn they must be small studs and should not be worn on PE days. If a child is not able to remove them they must be covered by a plaster to fulfil Health and Safety. The school cannot accept any responsibility for loss or damage to personal property.

Hair

Children's hair should not be dyed or have any temporary hair colour in it. We ask that long hair is tied up and short hair should be no shorter than a number 3. Patterns should not be cut into hair nor should hair styles be extreme for either boys or girls.

Make up

Children should not wear makeup in school. This includes nail polish, tattoos or henna transfers.

Personal belongings

Valuables and large amounts of money should not be brought into school.

We advise that children do not to bring from home into school - games, teddies and cuddly toys, electronic toys and games, sports balls and equipment
